Now you are asking yourself what you can do to get out of your contract. Well, first thing we ask is: have you thought long and hard about what you are looking to do with your career? As your potential new player agent we ask that you write a letter to your agent detailing that you are not interested in working with them as your player agent stating reasons why. Ensure that you sign it, date it and make a copy to keep for yourself and maybe to possibly send to us to cover our backs. We expect that if your agent was any good he would get in touch with you to mediate with you otherwise will simply release you from your player agent contract.

In the standard player NRL Accredited Player Agent contract, withdrawing from an existing contract means:

**6. TERMINATION**

- (a) Where the Player is in material breach of his obligations or any one of them under this Agreement, the Agent may terminate this Agreement on the giving of seven (7) days' written notice to the Player to that effect, in which event this Agreement will come to an end at the expiration of that period of notice.
- (b) Where the Agent is in material breach of his or her obligations or any one of them under this Agreement, or where the Agent ceases to carry on business as an agent of players for a continuous period of two months, then the Player may terminate this Agreement on the giving of seven (7) days' written notice to the Agent to that effect, in which event this Agreement will come to an end at the expiration of that period of notice.
- (c) Where the Player or the Agent:
  - (i-) Becomes bankrupt;
  - (ii) Enters into any arrangement or composition with creditors;
  - (iii) Engages in behaviour unbecoming to his position and reputation as a Player or Agent, as the case may be;
  - (i) Is convicted of any criminal offence punishable by imprisonment exceeding two years;
- (d) Where the Agent has his Accreditation Cancelled or ceases to be an Accredited Agent. the other party may terminate this Agreement forthwith on the giving of notice in writing to the former, in which event this Agreement will forthwith come to an end.

Note also that if successful in terminating your NRL Player Agent contract that you may have to pay commission on any contract signed to your previous NRL Player Agent for the duration of this time.
